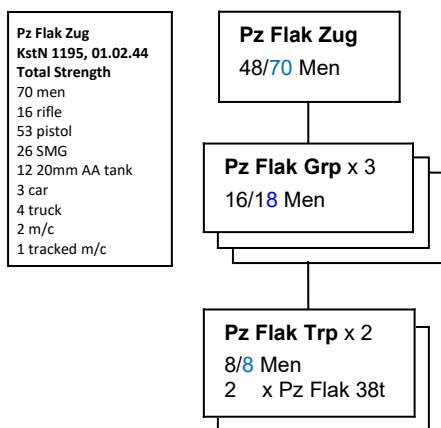


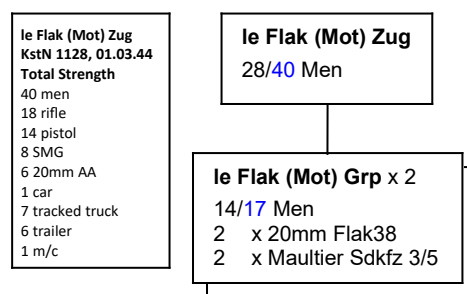
Gr Panzer Flak (Mobile) Units

Pz Flak Zug A (KstN 1196a(TE), 1.04.1943) There's no known KstN for this date so use one of the variants dated 1.2.1945. However, that one lists the Flakpanzer IV as being used but the first Flakpanzer IV did not become available until around Apr 1944. I do not know if this KstN was used at this date but if it was use SdKfz 6/2 and SdKfz 7/1 in place off the Ostwind and Wirbelwind.

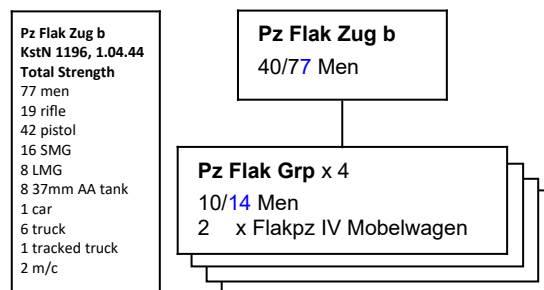
Pz Flak Zug* (KstN 1195(TE), 01.02.1944)

Note

Prior to early 1943 most German Div did not have there own organic Flak Bn assigned to them. Luftwaffe Flak Bn being attached as needed. Generally most Rgt/Abt did have there own organic Local Air Defence zug assigned. Flakpanzers thelvses were almost exclusively used in Heeres/SS Pz units.

All of the zug sized Flakpanzer units were Teileinheit (TE) or Partial Unit. The normal German practice for TE units was to assign them to Schwere (HW) Kp however Flakpanzers were not, being assigned to the Flak Abt or PzJ Abt. The exception being KstN 1128/9 which was still attached to the Schwere Kp.

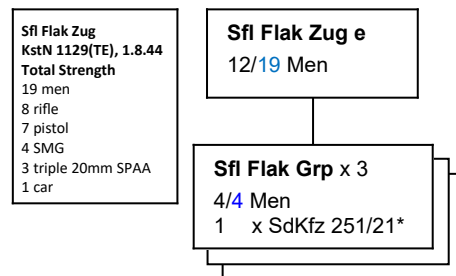
* Pz-Flak 38t or Gepard, the first effective Flakpanzer. There was a much earlier Flakpanzer I (1941) that was not very effective and as rare as hens teeth (maybe 20) and from what I seen all destroyed by 1943. anyway.

** Teileinheit (TE) or Partial Unit. This one was used in

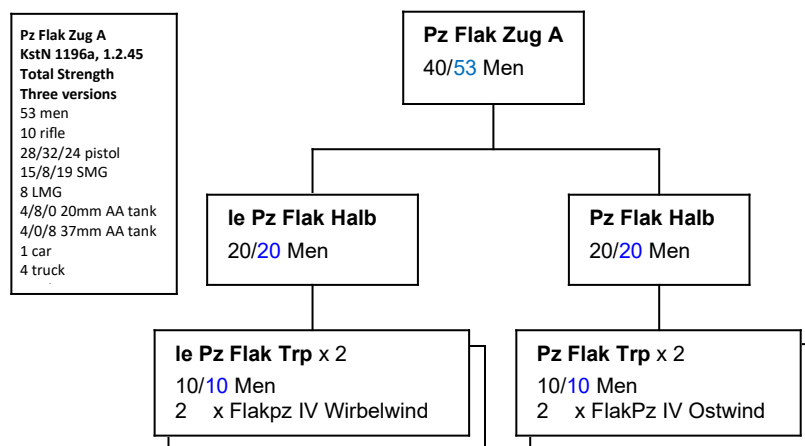

Pz Flak Zug A (KstN 1196a(TE), 1.06.1944) There's no known KstN for this date so use one of the variants dated 1.2.1945. However that one lists the Ostwind and Wirbelwind as being used but the Ostwind was not available until Nov 1944 so use the Möbelwagen in lieu.

Pz Flak Zug A (KstN 1196a, 1.02.1945)**



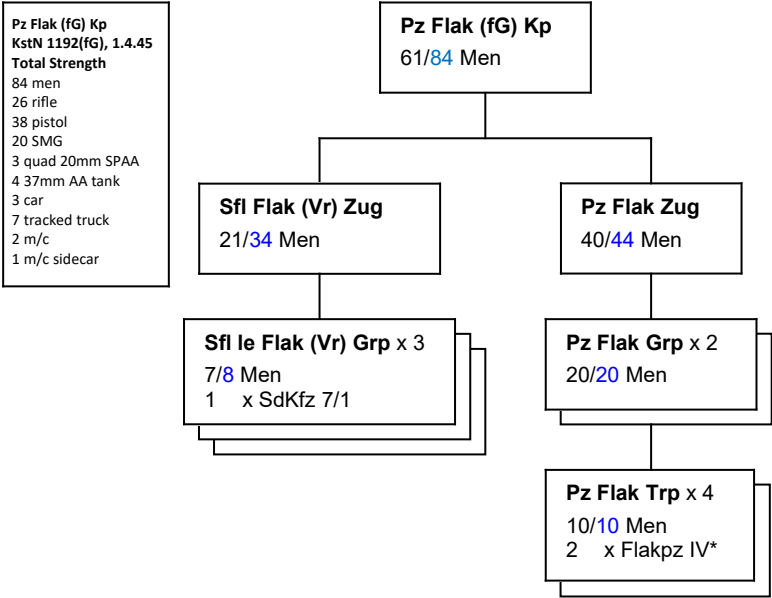
Notes

At this time there were never enough Flakpanzer available to equip all the Pz Abt therefore Flakpanzers were normally attached to Pz Rgt and Pz Div.

* The SdKfz 251/21 was fitted with the MG 151/20 Drilling, a triple 20mm gun.

** There were three variations, mixed as shown, one with 8 x Wirbelwind only and another with 8 x Ostwind only. There are two earlier versions dated 01.04.43 and 01.06.44 but as the various Flakpanzer IV were not available, especially in 1943, substitutes should be made.
